As Barack Obama's victory makes presidential history, *Firsts*, an exhibit on loan from the Separate Cinema Archive of Hyde Park, N.Y., looks back on how motion pictures have celebrated earlier African-American accomplishments by men and women who overcame racial barriers to realize lifelong dreams.

Pioneers of virtually every professional area routinely participated in by African-Americans in the 21st century, have antecedents in the 20th century. The exhibit illustrates a compelling selection of movie posters from big-budget Hollywood films to independent productions highlighting those who dared to succeed.
